WHO CAN ATTEND DAY CAMP?

- ◆ Any registered Cub Scout going into the 1st thru 5th grade.
- ◆ Cub Scouts (Wolf and Bear) will be grouped together to participate in activities appropriate to those ranks.
- ◆ Webelos scouts will experience more challenging activities for older cub scouts.
- ◆ New Tiger Cubs are welcome to attend with an adult partner.

RESERVATIONS

- ◆ **Your PACK DAY CAMP COORDINATOR MUST make all reservations.**
- ◆ The Pack is responsible for collecting registration forms, health forms, and fees for scouts/ walking leaders/tot lot children and registering them at the Scout Service Center or Twin Arrows Roundtable (April 9th or May 14th).
- ◆ Space is limited to the first 250 applications received per week. Those received after the deadline cannot be guaranteed.
- ◆ If your pack does not have a day camp coordinator, contact your cubmaster or committee chair or the camp coordinator.

SUPERVISION

- ◆ Trained adult leaders and Boy Scouts will be the basis of our program staff.
- ◆ Your Pack will be required to provide adult walking leaders that will accompany the boys during the day. They will assist with programs, safety and discipline. Adults must be at least 21 years old and have a health form on file.
- ◆ Each pack will need to supply 1 adult for every 5 boys attending camp. A minimum of Two (2) leaders will need to be provided for the Wolf/Bear Scouts **and** two (2) for the Webelos Scouts, requiring a minimum of 4 walking leaders each day to ensure 2-deep leadership. Each pack needs to have one adult per day available to lead a program area. Adults must be at least 21 years old and have a health form on file.
- ◆ **Tiger Cubs must have an adult partner with them at all times per BSA policy.**
- ◆ Walking Leader Orientation Sessions will be conducted the Saturday before day camp. This training is required per the National BSA Standards for Day Camp.

TRANSPORTATION

- ◆ Transportation to and from camp each day is the responsibility of the parents and the pack committee. We recommend that you arrange car pools for your scouts.
- ◆ Please plan to arrive each day at 8:30 am to organize your campsite and check in Scouts, Walking Leaders and Siblings before the opening flag ceremony.

HEALTH FORMS

- ◆ **EVERYONE** (Scouts, Walking Leaders, Staff, Siblings) **MUST** submit a signed Health Form with registration. These must be kept on file with the Health Officer at camp. Participation in camp will not be allowed without a Health Form.

LUNCH

- ◆ **EVERYONE** (Scouts, Walking Leaders, Staff, Siblings) will need to bring a sack lunch and a drink each day.
- ◆ Caution: Please do not send anything that can spoil quickly and make a person become ill.
- ◆ Packs are asked to bring ice chests to keep lunches and drinks in, ice will be available for purchase at the trading post.

Tot Lot

- ◆ Day Camp is for registered cub scouts only.
- ◆ The Tot Lot is a sibling camp for Non-Cub Scout siblings. The parent must be an on-site walking leader or staff member. It will consist of girls and boys 3 and up (MUST be potty trained).
- ◆ The Tot Lot will have at least one Adult Volunteer staffing it. Additional staffing may be through the use of teenage volunteers and boy scouts (14 or older).
- ◆ The cost for this service is \$3 per day.
- ◆ Parents must pick up their children for the lunch break and return them to the Tot Lot after lunch. Siblings will no be allowed to accompany their parents to the program areas for safety reasons.
